Thank you for attending this noise wall community meeting for the Northwest Corridor Project on I-75 and I-575. In this handout package you will find a project location map, a comment form, and a newsletter. The objective of this meeting is to present new noise wall locations based on revised noise analysis criteria recently adopted by Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT), that were not presented during the Supplemental Draft Environmental Impact Statement (SDEIS) public hearing open house held in October 2010.

As you enter the room, a special automated presentation will give you an overview of the project. Additionally, there are aerial displays of the preliminary layout for the project along with display boards that show the new noise wall locations and other additional information. Georgia Department of Transportation representatives, identified by their name tags, are available to discuss the project and answer your questions about noise walls or any other question you may have on the Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) that is currently available for public review and comment. There will be no formal presentation.

As a convenience to you, we have provided a number of different ways for you to give us your comments on this project. A court reporter is available for those persons who would like to make a verbal statement about the noise walls or the project in general. You may also complete a comment card and deposit it into the box provided here or send in written comments about the project until the comment period ends on November 21, 2011.
